As a cable technician for HTTS LLC I run CAT 6 (copper) and optical fiber (multi and single mode), drop it to selected locations, and assist in termination of the head as well as tail ends. We run the cable to code, which means either using straps, trays, or running the cable through the red iron to place it above the ceiling grid. I've also installed a considerable amount of Panduit raceway in various sizes and lengths. The majority of installs are on masonry walls, so measurement and the use of concrete anchors is required.

As a photographer for the Arka Tech I photographed events and collected information about subjects processed photos, wrote cut-lines, and submitted photos by deadline. Loading and unloading kilns required very delicate handwork. When it was time to fire the glaze kiln a high amount of attention to detail was required to prevent pots from sticking to one another or the kiln.

We did virus removal, spyware removal, operating system repair, operating system installation, hardware diagnostics, hardware replacement, hardware installation, data recovery, general troubleshooting, and other technical work. Sometimes we would also make house calls or go fix the wireless equipment around town.
